The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

After introducing committee members and potential new member Marie Nycz O'Neill of Madbury, we briefly explained how the Long Range Planning Committee works. We also talked about the elementary school enrollment projections, which we sent to Denise Day and elementary principals in October.

We reviewed the change in the projections since the last meeting, which impacted the number of projected high school tuition students from Barrington. (The elementary school projections did not change.)

Lisa Allison presented the draft LRPC PowerPoint presentation and several changes were suggested. One suggestion is to note what total HS enrollment will be in future years if 125 tuition students enroll (LRPC projections peak at 100). Robert Mohr, the committee member who is abroad this semester, had sent an email with his recommendations for changes. We discussed them and they will be implemented.

We decided to request that Denise Day recommend appointment of Rob McEwan and Marie Nycz O'Neill to fill the two open LRPC positions from Madbury.

We will have another meeting this year and invite the other Madbury community members who have shown an interest in the committee, in anticipation of Lorna Jacobsen wanting to resign by the end of the year.

The LRPC report to the School Board will be made on November 19 or December 3 (if the 19th is not available).

The committee will meet again on Monday December 8.

The meeting adjourned at 8:10.
